Applicable to: Shipowners, managers and holders of certificates of competency at management level, issued by foreign administrations serving on Mongolian ships

REGULATION I/10 OF STCW95 (RECOGNITION OF CERTIFICATES) - FAMILIARISATION WITH MONGOLIA'S MARITIME LEGISLATION

Regulation I/10 of STCW95 requires officers holding certificates of competency of management level, issued by foreign maritime administrations, employed on Mongolian ships of management level, must have an appropriate knowledge of Mongolia's maritime legislation relevant to the functions they are permitted to perform onboard.

Holders of certificates issued by foreign maritime administrations under the provisions of regulations II/2, III/2 or III/3, or issued under VII/1 at the management level, as defined in the STCW Code, are required to show evidence that they are familiar with the relevant maritime legislation when applying for a certificate of endorsement to serve on Mongolian ships. The Mongolian Sea Exploitation Law, Merchant Shipping Ship Registration) Regulations, Merchant Shipping (Certification and Manning) Rules and Mongolian Marine Circulars are downloadable from the Mongolia Ship Registry's Web site at www.mgnship.mn

Owners and ship managers are to ensure that their seafarers (with management level) employed on Mongolian ships had read and familiarized with the Mongolian Maritime Legislation before applying for the certificate of endorsements (COEs) and posting them on Mongolian ships. Management level Officers have to declare and submit the attached form to the Registry for record and the issuance of COEs.
