Applicable to: Shipowners, ship managers, agents, classification societies, ship masters and the shipping community

REPORTING A MARINE CASUALTY OR INCIDENT ON A MONGOLIAN SHIP

When a marine accident occurred involving a Mongolian ship, the Master or owner of the Mongolian vessel shall make a report to the Mongolia Ship Registry as soon as practicable and in any case not later than 24 hours after the ship's arrival at the next port.

The report shall contain information as stipulated in the "[Report of a Marine Casualty](#)" form, which is attached.

Failure to comply with this Circular, without reasonable excuse shall subject the owner/master of a ship to a criminal offence and is liable to a maximum fine of USD5,000.

If a Mongolian ship is lost or believe to have been lost, the owner or agent shall inform the Mongolia Ship Registry as soon as possible and submit a brief report, specifying:

- (a) The probable cause of the loss of the ship; and
- (b) The name, IMO numbers, Official numbers, crew list, Inmarsat numbers, bound from to where and last reported or known position.
