### ANNEX 3

#### SERVICE ON PASSENGER AND RO-RO PASSENGER SHIP

Prior to service on board passenger and ro-ro passenger vessels engaged in international voyages, Masters, officers and ratings, who have designated/assigned specific duties and responsibilities, are required to provide documentary evidence of having achieved the required standards of competence, in accordance with the Table given below.

1	Personnel designated on muster lists to assist passengers	Crowd management	A-V/2 para.1	A-V/3 para.1

3	Personnel providing direct service to passengers in passenger spaces	Communication and life saving appliances	A-V/2 para.3	A-V/3 para.3
4	Personnel with immediate responsibility for the passenger safety, cargo safety, hull integrity	Passenger safety, cargo safety, hull integrity	A-V/2 para.4	A-V/3 para.4
5	Personnel having responsibility for safety of passengers in emergency situations	Crisis management and human behaviour	A-V/2 para.5	A-V/3 para.5

2. The documentary evidence mentioned in paragraph (1) above should be issued by Parties that have been found to give full and complete effect to the provisions of the revised STCW Convention.

Every person who is required to be trained in accordance with item 1,4, and 5 of the above Table shall, at intervals not exceeding five years, undertake appropriate refresher training or be required to provide evidence of having achieved the required standard of competence within the previous five years.
